



EIFFEL SCHOLARSHIP 2023/24

The Eiffel Excellence Scholarship Program was established by the French Ministry for Europe and Foreign Affairs to enable French higher education institutions to attract top international students to enroll in their Masters and PhD programs. Applications for Master's students are managed by the Grenoble INP/UGA International Relations Department.

The EIFFEL scholarship offers merit-based grants to international students.

Only French higher education institutions can preselect candidates and send an online application on their behalf on the Campus France website. Applications submitted directly by students or by non-French educational institutions will be rejected.

Eligible fields of study are:

- Economics and Management
- Engineering (Master's level)
- Law
- Political Science

Grant amount

€1,181 per month

Grant duration

- Maximum 12 months for students in second year Master's programs (M2)
- Maximum 24 months for students in first year Master's programs (M1)
- Maximum 36 months for students preparing for an Engineering degree

Procedure

1) Pre-selection Grenoble IAE/INP

Between the 10th of October and the 26th of October 2022 : candidates must:

- **Download and read carefully the practical guide, this procedure and the criterias of eligibility:**

- **Send in a single PDF file all the documents** listed below to the Grenoble IAE International Relations Department (incomingstudents@grenoble-iae.fr)
 - **Resume** in French or English (1 to 2 pages) specifying the candidate's performance.
 - **Transcripts of records** of the last 3 years.
 - **Diplomas:** copies of the last degrees obtained with the date, the mentions, and the final grades certified by the institution, and any other document attesting the excellence of the candidate.
 - **Ranking** (for Transcripts of records and diplomas) : The candidate's performance must be specified, and justified by : honors, ranking, position within the class, number of students in the class, If transcripts or diplomas do not indicate rank, a certified letter from the institution specifying the student's rank may be issued.
 - **In the case of double degree** : the agreement between both institutions, and procedure related to this double degree must be joined.
 - The candidate's **Professional Project** written in French or English (1 to 2 pages). It should specify the choice of studies in France in relation to previous studies and future professional career.
 - **Letter of recommendation** (if available, not mandatory)
 - A photocopy of the **passeport or proof of identity**.
 - **Language Certificate or Diploma** (certificate of level of French and English for programs taught in French / and certificate of level of English for programs taught in English). For native speakers of French or English, the nationality can be sufficient with the corresponding identity document, to prove the level of the native language.
 - **Indicate the selected Master's degree.**

Only Complete applications will be sent to the program director by the International Relations Department of Grenoble IAE. If the application is selected by the program director, the candidate will be invited to a 30 minutes zoom interview.

2) Grenoble IAE/Grenoble INP Selection

Between the 15th of november and 09th of December 2022

The results of the Grenoble IAE-INP pre-selection will be communicated to the students from November 15th.

Students who receive a favorable decision from the INP selection committee will be contacted by the International Department of Grenoble IAE to complete the Campus France procedure. The Campus France form will be filled online by the International Relations department of Grenoble IAE.

***Please note** :The Eiffel program dos not replace the Campus France and Grenoble IAE recruitment campaigns. Students applying for the Eiffel Scholarship must also submit an application via Campus France and eCandidat.*
